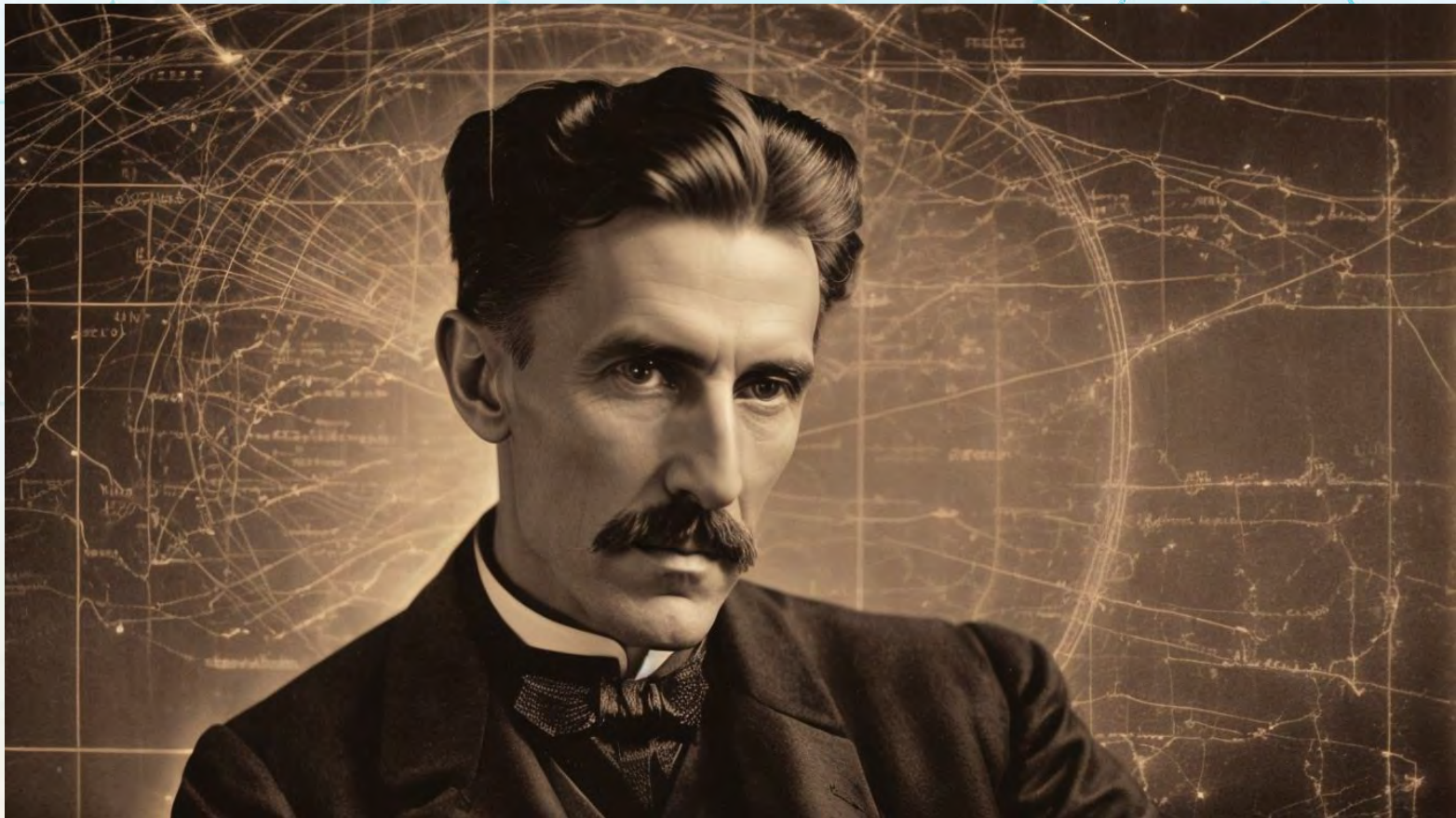
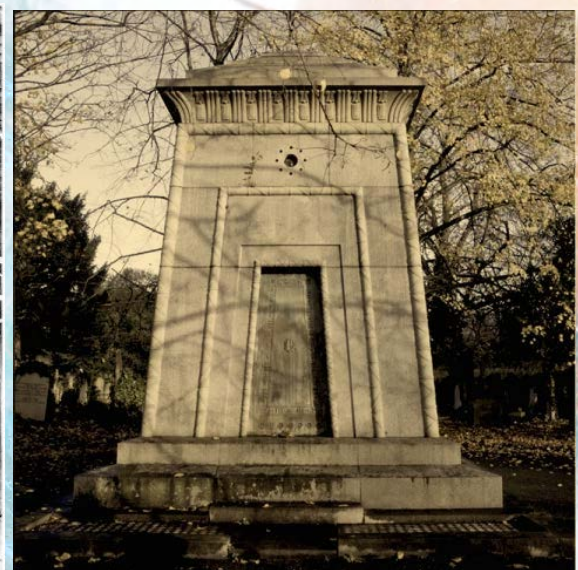
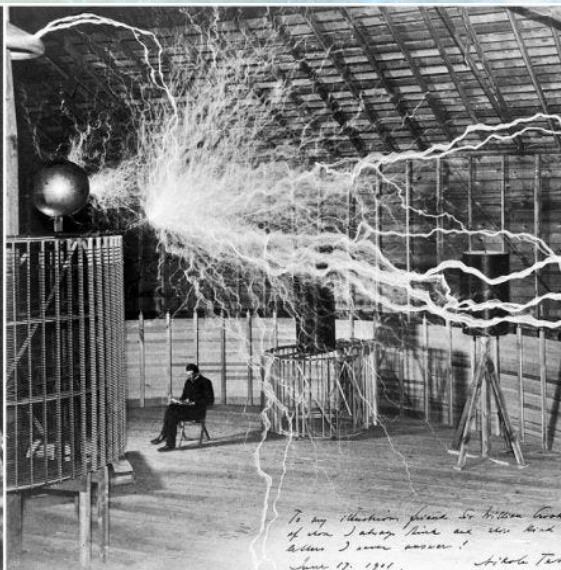
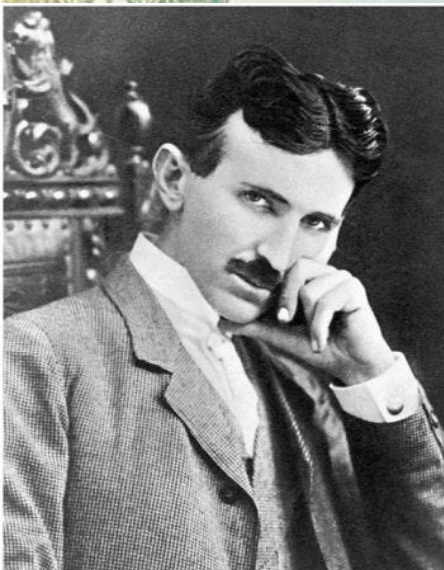


AN ADVENTURE IN TIME - CHARACTERS

Although he is a fictional character, Professor Wells is inspired by several real-life people. These include the famously eccentric visionary inventor, Nickolai Tesla, the Swiss psychiatrist, Carl Jung (many of whose concepts such as 'synchronicity' and the 'shadow self' are incorporated within our film), the writer, JB Priestley who was described as a 'time-haunted' man, and HG Wells who apparently was inspired to write his seminal novel 'The Time Machine' by hearing the legend of the 'Brompton Time Machine' (image above right)



Professor Wells has studied and worked at the university for almost his entire life, as did his father and his father before him, and the family's connection with scientific exploration reaches centuries into the past with several of the Professor's being recorded as being the leading alchemists of their time.

The Professor is the last of this illustrious line and his entire life has been dominated by his obsession to discover the true nature of time. This obsession has led him to be dismissed by his academic peers and he no longer feels part of the modern world. It is only when he makes his breakthrough in time travel and meets Emily that he feels his life can finally begin...
